

SCHOLARSHIPS: FAQ'S

DOES SAC OFFER SCHOLARSHIPS FOR CAMP?

SAC does have scholarships available. However, funding is limited so apply early.

WHAT KIND OF SCHOLARSHIPS CAN I APPLY FOR?

The scholarship application lists three types of scholarships that you can apply for: full cash scholarship (to be applied directly to camp tuition), partial cash scholarship (to be applied directly to camp tuition), and a working scholarship.

WHAT IS A WORKING SCHOLARSHIP?

A working scholarship is when a parent or family member is willing to offer a service or working hours to SAC in exchange for tuition. Services may include but are not limited to: videography services, photography services, counselor services, catering services, printing services, etc. Working hours could include hours spent as a camp counselor, making photocopies, running errands, helping at registration, etc.

HOW DO I GET A SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION?

There are two ways you can get a scholarship application. You can visit the website at www.wvsummerartcamp.com and click on the page "Camp Information." From there scroll down to the camp you are interested in registering for and you will see a link on the right side that says "Scholarship Application." Print the registration from that link. The second way is to call or email the office and ask for an application to be mailed to you. We do not accept applications online or by email due to the sensitive personal financial information that must be included.

IS THERE A DEADLINE FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS?

Yes. All applications along with the registration form and all required documentation must be RECEIVED by May 15th. There are no exceptions.
