

Partial Camp and Pro-rated Tuition

Can my child attend just one week of a two-week camp if we have a vacation or scheduling conflict? We have allowed campers to come for half of the camp though we do not encourage it. When campers come for the first week only, they miss out on finishing their projects in any art classes and they are not able to attend the Showcase on the last day. When campers come for the second week only, some could feel behind and they may not be included in certain portions of the performance class during the show. All in all they do not get the full benefit and experience that we offer at SAC.

Would my camp tuition be pro-rated if we only attended one week? Under these circumstances tuition would be pro-rated but it would not be a 50% pro-rate. It would be 75%. The reason for this is that your child would be occupying a space in classes that could be filled by a camper paying full tuition. We appreciate your understanding in this matter.

If my child only attends one week of camp, how would we get their projects if we are not there on the last day? Your child would be required to take their projects home on the last day they are in attendance. Their art work would not be displayed in the Art Exhibit. SAC does not have a place to store art work that is not taken home by the last day of camp.
